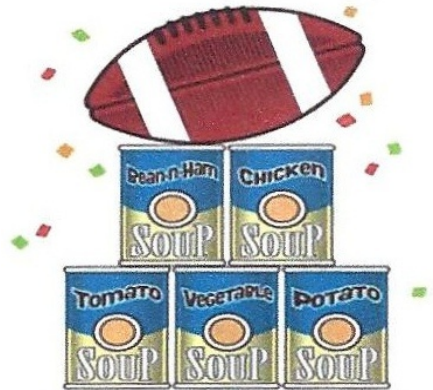
## Senior “Lunch Bunch” Sunday, January 29!

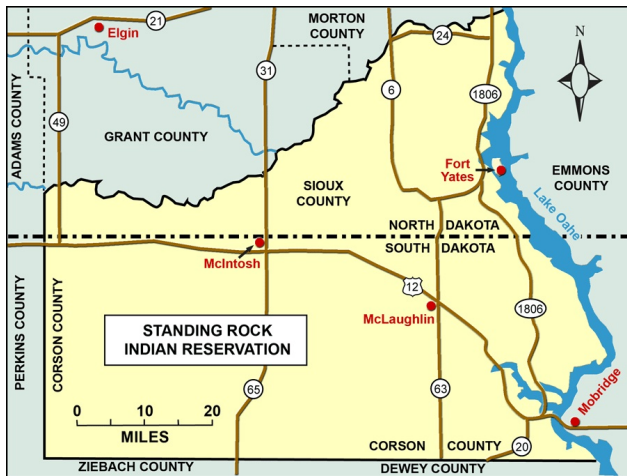
## Soup and Socks
